The museum is looking for some help during the months of **June, July, and August** in the following areas:

Gift Shop: Mondays. Shifts are 9:15 – 12:45 for a.m. and 12:45 – 4:00 for the afternoon. Candidates need to have a smiling personality and good people skills. Training is offered.

Greeters: 1 shift per week. Choose morning or afternoon shift (9:30 – 12:45 in the a.m. shift and 12:45 – 4:00 is the p.m. shift). This is a fun position if you enjoy children. Training is provided. Stamping hands, getting guests oriented to the museum and helping with questions about the area are some of the main duties. You'll be at the front desk area. Seating can be arranged so you won't be standing for 3 hours.

Front Desk Volunteers: 1 shift per week. Choose morning or afternoons. Training provided. Some knowledge of cash registers is welcomed, but not necessary.

Aquarium Volunteers: Learn about the wonderful creatures that inhabit our marshes, bays and ocean. Interact with guests who are eager to learn and explore.

Museum Interpreters: Help our guests inside of the museum on the theme of change in our front corridor, new exhibit hall or marshview room. You choose. Training provided. 1 shift per week. Mornings or afternoons.

Museum Library: 1 shift per week. Training provided. Former training in a library setting is appreciated, but not necessary. We use a card catalog.

Telephone Help: 1 shift per week. Helping our busy office staff with telephone calls. Training provided.
