Supply List/Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures/Discipline Procedures (Please Keep This Sheet)

Supplies

Please pack every item on this list **every day** of KidSummer:

- A backpack to store your child's personal belongings
- Comfortable sneakers that can get dirty for hiking.
Due to the terrain and boardwalks, CROC or Flip Flops are not the safest choice.
- A pair of aqua socks or old sneakers for walking in water and mud.
- A jacket or sweatshirt for field activities or in case of a change in weather.
- Sunscreen. Please apply before KidSummer begins for the day.
- Insect repellent. Please apply before KidSummer begins for the day.
- A re-fillable water bottle.
- A hearty, healthy snack.
- A change of clothes.
- A hat.
- A towel (for drying and sitting).

In addition to the above, our COVID protocols require the following items:

- Mask.
- Hand sanitizer.
- Re-fillable water bottle.

First Day Check-In and Drop off

On the first day of KidSummer you will need to find your child's "classroom." Look for the KidSummer Staff directing you. At this time your child will receive a T-shirt & wristband and you will receive a wristband as well as a KidSummer Dashboard Card to identify you as a KS parent along with any other pertinent information.

*Additional T-shirts are available for sale for \$5.00 in the KS Office.

Remember, we cannot allow your child to attend KidSummer if we do not have all completed paperwork - which includes our Emergency release form, Parent Medical Form and Immunization Record/Physical exam report within the last 24 months from your child's physician.

Drop off is at 8:30 AM and Pick up is at 12:30 PM.

See special pick up directions at registration.

If you are more than 10 minutes late picking up your child, we will assess a child care fee of \$5.00 for each 5 minutes you are late, past 12:40 PM, at the discretion of the administrator. Your child will be in the KidSummer office.

*****Please try to drop off on time as we often start our field activities upon everyone's arrival. If your child is going to be absent/late, please call the Museum at 508-896-3867, ext. 128 to let us know; your child's group may be leaving to go outside for field activities.**

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

If your child exhibits inappropriate behavior or behavior which could cause harm to other children or themselves, the following course of action will be taken:

1. Instructors will speak to your child about the situation and notify parents/guardians when they are picked up.
2. If negative behavior is seen a second time, a child will receive "time out" and then return to activity. Parent/guardian will be notified of said behavior.

Depending on the severity of behavior, parent may be asked to remove the child from the program.

Prohibitions for disciplinary action towards children:

- (1) Corporal punishment, including spanking, is unacceptable.

- (3) No child shall be denied food or shelter as a form of punishment.
- (4) No child shall be punished for soiling, wetting, or not using the toilet.
